Bhajan Kaur's son from village Tangra, Amritsar had died in a road accident some time back. Bhajan Kaur is living with her daughter-in-law and 2 grandchildren, there is no one to earn in the family. Bhajan Kaur is elderly, her daughter-in-law is physically handicapped and both the children are young. Our team has promised financial support every month to them and this month too they have been financially supported.

Our aim is to support the young generation of the villages who want to study and those who want to learn in any way possible. To help them get a job for themselves in the near future. In addition, the graduation fee of a daughter living in Bathinda is paid by SimbaQuartz.

The evening school is closed for some time keeping in mind the prevailing situation and the health of the children. Children can still call at any time to get information about the education from our team.
